The meeting will be held in Scopwick Village Hall on Wednesday 22nd January at 7pm.


All residents of Scopwick and Kirkby Green are welcome to attend.

It is vitally important that everyone in the community understands the next steps and has an opportunity to have their say whether pro or against the Springwell Solar Farm.


